## **REGULATION AND RULES OF CONDUCT**

Read carefully the following regulation, and strictly follow what is specified. This regulation was created to protect the safety of people and respect for the territory. Following the simple rules specified below will allow the traveler to fully and safely enjoy the experience, without affecting or compromising the local flora and fauna.

Strictly follow the instructions provided by the guide.

Respect the agreed times and the schedule.

Share spaces and seats in respect of all the passengers of the vehicle.

It is forbidden to carry with you: weapons, explosives, flammable materials. throw waste like cans, bottles, plastic bags, etc.

Keep any rubbish and store it in the appropriate spaces outside the parks.

Never get out of the vehicle inside the parks, unless driving allows it.

Warn the guide about any disabilities, intolerances or problems in general.

Do not remove any property within the Parks, including any species of flora and fauna.

Keep silence and discipline within the Parks, do not shout, do not whistle, do not harass animals.

Do not feed the animals

Do not try to touch any animals

Drones are not allowed in the parks (authorization from the competent local authority is required) Carrying alcohol or drugs is not allowed Carrying animals is not allowed

To remain seated while the vehicle is in motion, it is possible to use the special opening on the roof of the vehicle to admire the animals only during stops, not to lean out of the windows and from the opening on the roof - the organizer is not responsible for any damage caused to himself or to third parties for failure to comply with this safety standard.

Don't take risks! Should dangerous situations occur or a person is in danger, contact the guide or staff immediately.

Any changes with respect to the established program must be previously agreed and authorized by the organizer, do not take personal initiatives.

During the Blue Safari it is not allowed to abandon the boat or dive while sailing.

Inside the lodges, hotels, tented camps, consult and comply with the structure regulations.

## **RULES OF CONDUCT**

Do not bring precious or valuable items with you during the tours - the organizer is not responsible for any theft or loss.

Wear comfortable and informal clothing.

Bring any therapies, medicines or medical devices with you.

Respect the Kenyan people, never photograph without asking permission first.

Do not donate money to people and children

Failure to comply with the aforementioned regulation will entitle the organizer to interrupt the tour at any time and / or, if necessary, will lead to legal action.
